

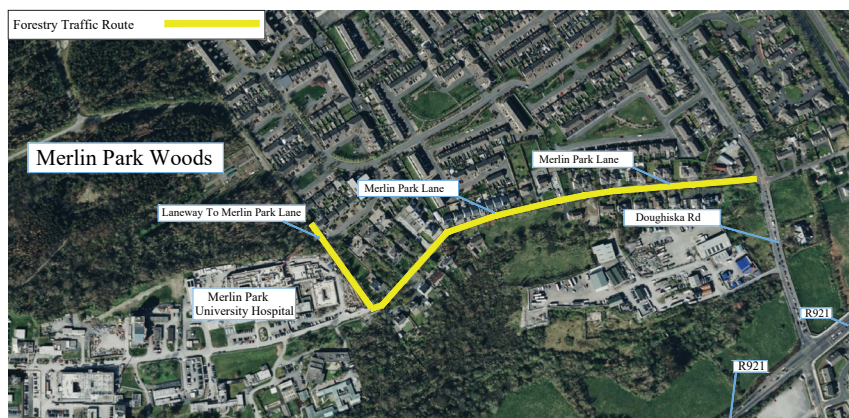
Merlin Woods Update

Removal of Fallen Trees | 31 August 2026

Following our information leaflet delivered to you in July, Galway City Council will progress tree removal works in the week commencing 7 September 2026. A Traffic Management Plan will be in place along the route outlined in the map on the right.



Site traffic movements will be restricted to 10:00am - 4:00pm and will likely last for 12 weeks (up to mid-December).

The Future Plan for Merlin Woods

Thank you to all those who attended the public information sessions in July on the future plan for Merlin Woods.

In September, Galway City Council will apply to the Department of Agriculture, Food and the Marine for funding to ensure Merlin Woods remains an accessible, attractive woodland for the local community.

If successful, this funding under the NeighbourWood Scheme could deliver amenities including trails, seating, picnic areas, a forest school, or orienteering routes for example. The funding will also ensure replanting of the woods with native species.

Securing departmental funding for the replanting of the woods and installation of amenity facilities is vital for the future of Merlin Woods.

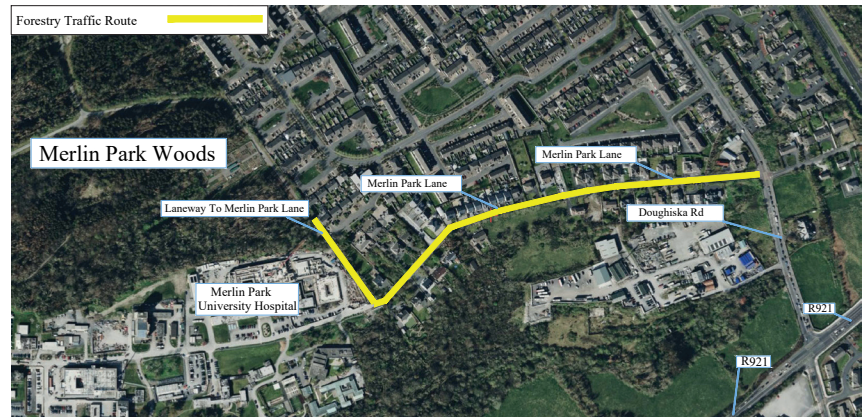
Nuashonrú maidir le Coill Mhuirlinne

Cuirfidh Comhairle Cathrach na Gaillimhe iarratas faoi bhráid na Roinne Talmhaíochta, Bia agus Mara ar mhaoiniú i mí Mheán Fómhair, lena chinntiú go bhfanfaidh Coill Mhuirlinne inrochtana agus tarraingteach don phobal áitiúil.
