

Ballybane Road and Castlepark Road Cycle Network Scheme

Coffey Construction Ltd., working on behalf of **Galway City Council**, are delivering the **Ballybane Road & Castlepark Road Cycle Network Scheme**. The scheme is funded by the **National Transport Authority (NTA)** and the Urban Regeneration and Development Fund.

Progress to date

This project remains on track for completion in **Q3 2026**. Along both Ballybane Road and Castlepark Road, construction on the **first side of each road is nearing completion**.

What happens next

We are now commencing works on the **second side of each road**. To do this safely, **traffic and pedestrian routes will change** at times over the coming months. These changes will be **clearly signposted** and managed by temporary traffic measures.

What you can expect

- Temporary traffic management, including **reduced speed limits** and **frequent, single-lane operation** under traffic signals in off peak times.
- Temporary **changes to pedestrian routes**; Please follow signed diversions.
- Access to homes and businesses will be maintained. **Emergency access will be available at all times.**
- Temporary Bus stop adjustments will be required; on-street notices will advise of any temporary relocations.

Work Schedule

- **Ballybane Road:** Works have now begun on the second (West) side of the road from the ATU heading North towards Walter Macken Road. Works are also due to begin in the area from Monivea Road heading South towards the ATU including works inside Monivea Park.
- **Castlepark Road:** Works have now begun on the second (West) side of the road from Ballybane/Castlepark Intersection, heading North to Monivea Road / Junction.

Traffic Management

- Traffic management measures will be in place throughout the works and some delays are to be expected.
- Two-way traffic will be maintained where possible. However, single-lane closures will be frequent during off-peak hours using a stop/go system.
- Some minor road closures may be required, with diversions ensuring residential access. Affected residents will be notified in advance.
- The completed design reduces the width sections of the carriageway and junctions to calm vehicle speeds and make room for safer cycling and walking facilities. Motorists should drive with care while getting used to the new layout.

Scheme Layout & Phasing

The project will be completed in phases, with works now moving onto the second side of both Ballybane and Castlepark Roads. Works will continue to progress on both roads simultaneously. Once each phase is substantially complete, the new infrastructure will be opened to the public.

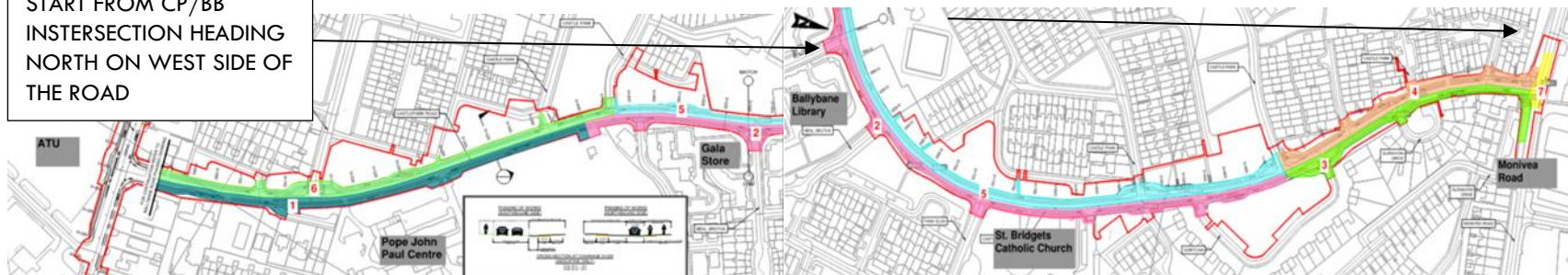
Ballybane Road Works Phasing order:
