

Ballybane Road and Castlepark Road Cycle Network Scheme

Notice of Footpath Closure in Vicinity of ATU Main Entrance

Coffey Construction Ltd. is working on behalf of Galway City Council to carry out the construction of the **Ballybane Road and Castlepark Road Cycle Network Scheme** which involves construction of new footpaths and a cycle track on both sides of the Ballybane and Castlepark Roads. As part of this project, we are writing to inform you of an upcoming footpath closure on Ballybane Road across from and adjacent to the ATU North Entrance as per highlighted sections below, along with works on the Ballybane/Castlepark Road Junctions. Access to local residents will be maintained during the works, but there may be some intermittent disruption where services will have to be laid and new concrete will have to be poured across residents' entrances temporarily disrupting vehicle access. This will be discussed with the residents on an individual basis and Coffey will work with residents as much as possible to minimise disruption. Your cooperation will be greatly appreciated and will assist with works being completed as quickly as possible.

Signage will be in place to advise walkers and wheelers of diversions.
