Compulsory Purchase Order No. BCCNS-CPO-001, 2024 in the City of Galway.

A Chara,

We refer to the planning development proposal as approved by the elected members of Galway City Council on the 11th September 2023 for the Ballybane Castlepark Cycle Network Scheme under Section 179 4(b) of the Planning & Development Act 2000 (as amended). In particular I refer to the proposed Compulsory Purchase Order No. BCCNS-CPO-001, 2024.

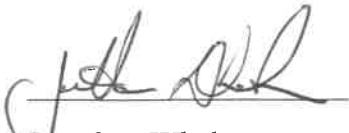
Please note that Galway City Council has received approval from the National Transport Authority to proceed to Phase 4 – Statutory Processes – Planning Stage.

The Ballybane Castlepark route is identified as part of a Primary Network in the Proposed Cycle Network from the Galway Transport Strategy. The route typifies both the opportunity and the challenges of urban cycling in Galway City. The scheme will involve the construction of the Ballybane Castlepark Active Travel Scheme which has an overall combined length of approximately 2400m, from R865 Ballybane Road, from its junction with the R339 Monivea Road to a point approximately 130m north of Skerritt Roundabout (R338 Dublin Road) and the L5029 Castlepark Road, from its junction with R865 Ballybane Road to its junction with R339 Monivea Road. The works will also include upgraded public lighting, landscaping and drainage amendments.

We recommend that the Compulsory Purchase Order BCCNS-CPO-001, 2024 be executed and enclose the following:

1. CE Order for authorising the making of the Compulsory Purchase Order,
2. Compulsory Purchase Order No. BCCNS-CPO-001, 2024,
3. Schedules Part I, Part II detailing landowners and occupiers of lands which are the subject of the Compulsory Purchase Order,
4. The deposit maps relating to the Compulsory Purchase Order,
5. Letters to landowners and occupiers which are subject to the Compulsory Purchase Order.

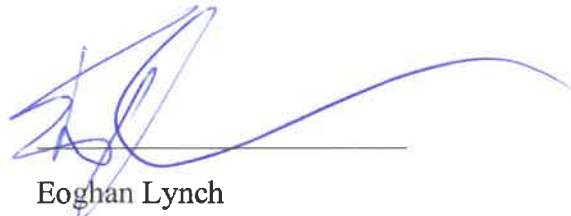
