

Compulsory Acquisition of Land

FORM OF NOTICE OF THE MAKING OF A COMPULSORY PURCHASE ORDER UNDER SECTION 76 OF AND THE THIRD SCHEDULE TO THE HOUSING ACT, 1966, AS EXTENDED BY SECTION 10 OF THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT (NO.2) ACT, 1960, TO BE PUBLISHED IN ACCORDANCE WITH ARTICLE 4 (a) OF THE THIRD SCHEDULE TO THE HOUSING ACT, 1966, AS AMENDED BY THE PLANNING AND DEVELOPMENT ACT, 2000 (AS AMENDED) AND UNDER SECTION 213 OF THE PLANNING AND DEVELOPMENT ACT 2000 (AS AMENDED), AND SECTION 184 OF THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT ACT 2001.

Ballybane Castlepark Active Travel Scheme

Galway City Council (hereinafter referred to as “the local authority”), in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section 76 of the Housing Act, 1966, and the Third Schedule thereto, as extended by section 10 of the Local Government (No. 2) Act, 1960 (as substituted by section 86 of the Housing Act, 1966) as amended by section 6 and the Second Schedule to the Roads Act, 1993 and as amended by the Planning and Development Act, 2000 (as amended), and under section 213 of the Planning and Development Act 2000 (as amended) and section 184 of the Local Government Act 2001, have made an order titled as above which is about to be submitted to An Bord Pleanála for confirmation.

If confirmed, the order will authorise the local authority to acquire compulsorily the land and/or rights described in Part I, Part II and Part IV (Section A) of the Schedule for the purposes of the construction of the Ballybane Castlepark Active Travel Scheme which has an overall combined length of approximately 2400m, from R865 Ballybane Road, from its junction with the R339 Monivea Road to a point approximately 130m north of Skerritt Roundabout (R338 Dublin Road) and the L5029 Castlepark Road, from its junction with R865 Ballybane Road to its junction with R339 Monivea Road, all in the County of Galway and within the Galway City Council administrative area , together with all ancillary and consequential works associated therewith.

If confirmed, the order will authorise the local authority to temporarily restrict or otherwise interfere with the private rights described in Part IV (Section C) of the Schedule.

Owners, lessees and occupiers of the land and/or rights described in the Schedule Part I, Part II and Part IV will receive individual written notice, and any objection by them to the compulsory acquisition of the land or rights described in the Schedule Part I, Part II and Part IV should be made in writing to An Bord Pleanála, 64 Marlborough Street, Dublin, D01 V902 to be received no later than 4.30pm on the 27th of September 2024.
