**Subject: Bóthar Stiofáin Active Travel Scheme
Compulsory Purchase Order No. BSATS-CPO-002, 2024**

I, Patrick Greene, Acting Chief Executive, Galway City Council, by virtue of the powers, functions and duties conferred on me by the Local Government Act 2001 as amended, rescind CE Order number 034482 due to the reconsideration and amending of the documentation attached in relation to the **Bóthar Stiofáin Compulsory Purchase Order No. BSATS-CPO-002, 2024**, (the “Compulsory Purchase Order”) hereby confirm and order that,

1. The lands as referred to and detailed in the Schedule in the attached report and accompanying maps be acquired compulsorily.
2. To acquire the private rights as described in the Schedule of the report and accompanying maps.
3. To restrict or otherwise interfere with the private rights described in the Schedule of the report and accompanying maps.
4. To temporarily restrict or otherwise interfere with the private rights described in the Schedule of the report and accompanying maps.
5. The Compulsory Purchase Order as aforesaid be prepared in the prescribed form, being for the purpose of the construction of Bóthar Stiofáin Active Travel Scheme in the City of Galway, together with the ancillary works associated therewith, and to introduce segregated cycletracks to both sides of the carriageway and to add a footpath to the eastern side of the carriageway and that the Official Seal of Galway City Council is to be affixed to the Compulsory Purchase Order and accompanying maps.

6. The statutory procedures to acquire the lands and or rights the subject of the Compulsory Purchase Order be commenced.
7. All statutory advertisements and notices be published and served in relation to the Compulsory Purchase Order.
8. The Compulsory Purchase Order, and the maps attached thereto, be sealed with the seal of the Galway City Council and submitted to An Bord Pleanála for confirmation.
