A meeting point

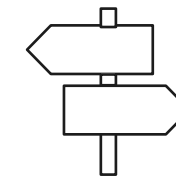

Biodiversity Trail

Native Planting

Planting inspired by the Connemara and Galway landscape using a mix of rewilding and small-scale planting to provide for wildlife, planting and amenity value.



Wayfinding

Linking the route

Strategy that provides guidance and permeability along the route. Opportunity to incorporate biodiversity trail information into signage using information boards or QR Codes. Alongside the addition of the destination, it further strengthens Millar's Lane as an interactive amenity rather than a passive route.



Existing Entrance Points

Access to the route

Existing entrance points to be enhanced to provide clarity as to location and route of Millar's Lane. Entrance points will also be designed with safety and security to the fore to ensure universal access along the route.



Potential Entry Points

Access to the route

Potential access points to provide permeability to surrounding residential roads. Opening up route to as many users as possible will encourage usability, provide additional linkage, and create shorter journey times between more locations in the vicinity of the Millar's Lane.
