

WELCOME TO THE 2ND ISSUE OF THE PARKMORE BUS PRIORITY SCHEME NEWSLETTER

Construction of the Parkmore Bus Priority scheme has been ongoing since the 19th February with good progress being made on works at Monivea Junction and Ballybrit Crescent. The following gives an outline of works planned for the next 4 weeks:-

Day shift works commencing 11th of March:

- Works will continue in Stage 2 Area highlighted in (red) from the 11th March to 22nd March.
- Works on the Eastern Footpath, Stage 3 area highlighted in (blue) will commence on the 19th March.
- Works will be carefully planned and sequenced in stages to minimise traffic disruption. Note, road crossings across Briarhill Business Park entrance will be completed at night to prevent traffic disruption
- Temporary traffic management measures, including pedestrian and cycleway diversions, will also be in place around the works areas as is necessary.



Night shift works:

- Night shift works will be ongoing in Stage Areas 1 and 2 highlighted in (green) and (red) from the 11th to 29th March.
- Night shift works will run from 7pm in the evening to approximately 6.00am the following morning.
- Temporary traffic management measures, including some lane closures, will be required from the Briarhill Junction to Parkmore Road to facilitate the works.
- Temporary pedestrian and cycleway diversions will also be in place around the works areas as is necessary.

Ballybrit Crescent Works (Dayshift Works):

- Works is progressing in the Ballybrit Crescent area (Highlighted in **Green**) with deep drainage and attenuation tank installation nearing completion.
- It is planned to continue with earthworks, ducting, kerbing and footpath works in this section in the next 4 weeks.
- Bus Stop construction and landscaping works is planned to be completed in April.
- Both entrances to Ballybrit crescent will be maintained for the majority of works, but there will be periods where one entrance will need to be closed to facilitate construction of the new pedestrian crossings, JCEL will liaise with property owners in advance to notify.
