

# SCOIL IOGNÁID UPDATE, SEPTEMBER 2023



The Safe Routes to School (SRTS) programme is working with schools and local authorities across Ireland to support improvements to front of school environments as well as routes to school. ## School Street

The School Street at Scoil Iognáid has been in operation since May 2022, starting initially as an informal school street with parents / guardians asked to voluntarily avoid driving to the school at school start and finish times and building up to a formal school street with statutory signage in place.

The School Street has been successful in reducing issues facing residents previously, such as school traffic blocking entrances to homes, and contributed to an increase in students walking, cycling, and scooting to school.

## Scoil Iognáid SRTS Scheme

To support the existing School Street at Scoil Iognáid, Galway City Council (GCC) will be commencing works on 18th September for the Scoil Iognáid SRTS scheme.

The works include:

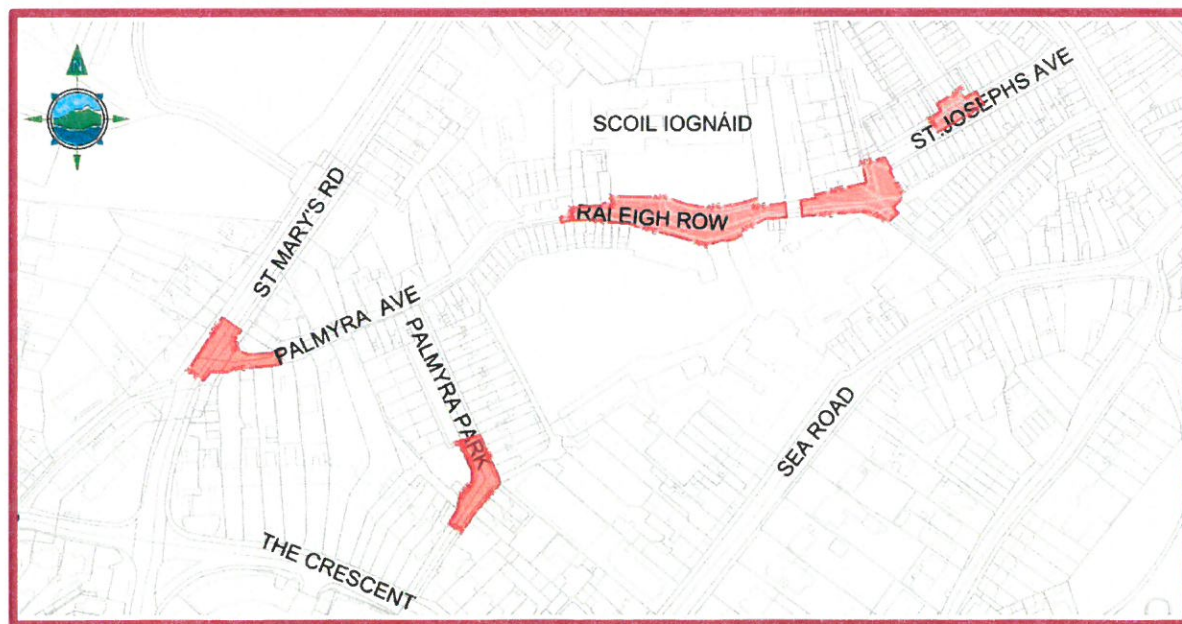
- Narrowing of carriageway width and widening of pedestrian footways.
- School gateway treatment with contrasting surface finish, signage and coloured circles fronting the school.
- Reintroduction of pencil bollards in front of the school.
- Upgrade to road marking and signage. Rigid bollards at residential areas to discourage parking on footways.
- Junction tightening and upgrade to crossings at 4 no. locations.

The expected duration for the works at the Front of School is 12 weeks.

All other junctions will be delivered independently.

Tá Sráid na Scoile ag Scoil Iognáid i bhfeidhm ó Bhealtaine 2022, ag tosú ar dtús mar shráid scoile neamhfhoirmeálta agus iarradh ar thuismitheoirí / caomhnóirí tiomáint chun na scoile ag amanna tosaithe agus críochnaithe a sheachaint go deonach leis an aidhm chun a bheith ina shráid fhoirmeálta le comharthaíocht reeachtúil i bhfeidhm.

D'éirigh le Sráid na Scoile na fadhbanna a bhí ag cónaitheoirí roimhe seo a laghdú, ar nós trácht scoile ag blocáil bealaí isteach chuig tithe, agus chuidigh sé le méadú ar líon na ndaltaí a bhí ag siúl, ag rothaíocht agus ag scútáil chun na scoile.

## Scéim SRTS Scoil Iognáid

Chun tacú le Sráid na Scoile atá ag Scoil Iognáid faoi láthair, beidh Comhairle Cathrach na Gaillimhe (CCnaG) ag cur tús le hoibreacha ar an 18ú Meán Fómhair do scéim SRTS Scoil Iognáid.

I measc na n-oibreacha tá:

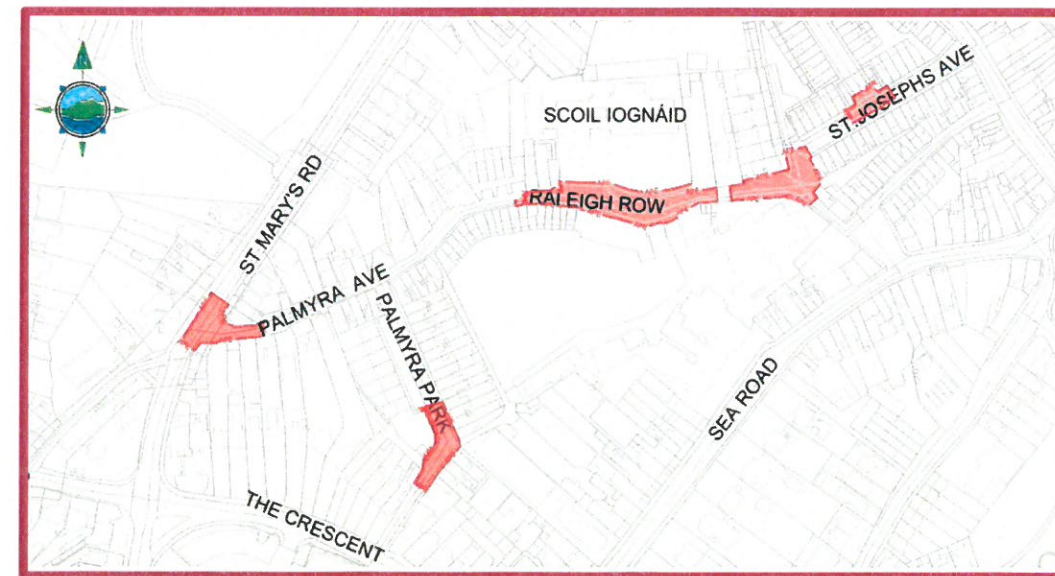
- Leithead an charrbhealaigh a laghdú agus cosáin choisithe a leathnú.
- Cóireáil gheata na scoile le bailchríoch dromchla codarsnacha, comharthaíocht agus ciorcail daite os comhair na scoile.
- Mullaird peann luaidhe a thabhairt isteach arís os comhair na scoile.
- Uasghrádú ar mharcáil bóithre agus ar chomharthaíocht. Mullaird docha ag ceantair chónaithe chun páirceáil ar bhóithre a dhíspreagadh.
- Neartú acomhal agus uasghrádú ar thrasrianta ag 4 uimh. suíomhanna.

Is é 12 seachtain an fad measta do na hoibreacha Ar Aghaidh na Scoile.

Déanfar gach acomhal eile a sheachadadh go neamhspleách.
