Curran on 29/08/2025 Referred from CPG Meeting 1 September 2025 to West Area Committee That this council will, during the lifetime of this council term, prepare a masterplan for the recreational areas of Bearna Woods, Rusheen Woods, Rusheen Bay and SilverStrand in consultation with all stakeholders. This masterplan will look to improve access and connections between the recreational areas, identify opportunities to increase the provision of amenity and play facilities, examine the potential for the large area of land in Rusheen Bay/Old Hunters caravan park, and improve infrastructure for all beach users at Silverstrand, cognisant of the ecology and fragile biodiversity of the area that lies within the SPC/SPA.
