We The City Bin Co wish to confirm that we would be in a position to provide a full Waste and Recycling Service collection at the proposed GCC development on the Headford Road, Galway.

In order to facilitate the proposed mixed development consisting of Houses & Apartments, we will be able to provide the following collection service to the development;

- General Waste: Collection of 1100L / 700L bins twice per week.
- Mixed Dry Recycling: Collection of 1100L / 700L bins twice per week.
- Food Bin (Organics): Collection of 240L bins weekly.
- Glass Bin: Collection of 240L bins weekly.

As part of a full commercial waste service, City Bin staff will transfer the bins from the bin storage area to the collection truck. All refuse would be collected from the development after 7.00am.

We have viewed the planning application drawings (SK (D)252 dated 13/09/2021), as part of our response. In our opinion the proposed bin store area to serve the development is of adequate size and would be a typical bin store provision for a development of this size.
