De bhun cheanglais Chuid XI den Acht um Pleanáil agus Forbairt 2000 (arna leasú) agus Chuid 8 Airteagal 81 de na Rialacháin um Pleanáil agus Forbairt 2001 go 2024, tugann Comhairle Cathrach na Gaillimhe le fios go bhfuil sé ar intinn ag an gComhairle an fhorbairt seo a leanas a chur in oiriúint ag an suíomh seo:

An páirc imeartha ar an taobh ó thuaidh de Sheanbhothar Bhaile Atha Cliath in aice le hÓstán Chonnacht agus Garraán Pháirc an Tobair.

Is éard atá i gceist sa bhforbairt ná reilig faoi fhéar a sholáthar a ffreastalóidh ar cheapacha uaigne, ceapacha síothaí, gairdín cuimhneacháin (lena n-áirítear limistéar le haghaidh taisí créamtha), bóithre rochtana, soláthar aconmhail, páirceáil, foirgneamh leasa fóirne, seid innealla, cóireáil teoirann, comharthaíocht, draenáil uisce dromchla, struchtúr chun taisí créamtha a imtheorannú, bunchlocha cinn agus tírdhreachú cuí ar fud an láithreáin chun tionchar amhaic na forbairtha beartaithe ar an láithreán a laghdú ar an gcomharsannacht buailte ar an suíomh.

Rinneadh scagadh le haghaidh Measúnú Cúir ar an bhforbairt de réir Airteagal 6(3) de Threoir an AE maidir le Gnáthóga (Treoir 92/43/CEE). Tháinig an Scagadh le haghaidh Measúnú Cúir ar an gconclúid nach dócha go mbeadh tionchar suntasach ag an bhforbairt bheartaithe ar aon láithreán Eorpach Natura 2000 agus nach bhfuil gá le Measúnacht Chúir maidir leis an bhforbairt bheartaithe seo.

Pursuant to the requirements of Part XI of the Planning & Development Act 2000 (as amended) and Part 8 Article 81 of the Planning and Development Regulations 2001 to 2024, Galway City Council hereby gives notice that it intends to carry out the following development located at:

The playing field on the north side of Old Dublin Road adjacent to The Connacht Hotel and Wellpark Grove.

The development will consist of the provision of a lawn cemetery which will cater for grave plots, urn plots, memorial garden (which will include an area for cremated remains), access roads, junction provision, parking, staff welfare building, machinery shed, boundary treatment, signage, surface water drainage, structure for the interment of cremated remains, headstone foundations and appropriate landscaping throughout the site to minimise the visual impact of the proposed development on the adjoining properties.

The development has been the subject of Screening for Appropriate Assessment in accordance with Article 6(3) of the EU Habitats Directive (Directive 92/43/EEC). The Screening for Appropriate Assessment concluded that the proposed development would not be likely to give rise to significant effects on any European Natura 2000 site and an Appropriate Assessment is not required in respect to this proposed development.

TEMPORARY CLOSING OF ROADS

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Galway City Council has made an order closing:-

High Street: From the Junction of Cross Street to the Junction of Shop Street.

Quay Street: From the Junction of Cross Street to the intersection with the exit from Leonardo Hotel is also to be closed to HGV traffic.

Period of Closure: 24/7 Monday 30th September 2024 to Friday 29th November 2024.

Reason: Street rehabilitation and drainage upgrade works.

Diversion Routes: Temporary diversion route will be in place via Mainguard Street, Cross Street, Flood Street, turning left on to the R336 New Dock Street to Merchants Road Lower and further right on the R336 continuing along the Spanish Parade.

Localised access will be maintained as permitted within the limitations of those within the existing pedestrianised zone.

Advance diversion signage will be in place prior to work commencing.
