T11 Prunus avium 12-14cm, 2.5-3.5m ht

Whips - 60-90cm ht., in random groups of 5-15 no at 2-4m/sq.m

*Corylus avellana - 15%
*Crataegus monogyna - 30%
Euonymus europaeus - 5%
Ilex aquifolium - 10%
*Ligustrum vulgare - 5%
*Malus sylvestris - 5%
*Prunus spinosa 20%
*Sambucus nigra - 5%

Wildflower meadow

Native Irish biodiversity seed mix for semi improved parkland soils
Recommended product: EC09 Species Rich Amenity Grassland
Sowing 1.5 grams per metre.

Sample species include:
Bird'sfoot Trefoil, Black Medick, Cowslip, Devil's Bit Scabious, Eyebright, Field Scabious, Greater Trefoil, Kidney Vetch, Lady's Bedstraw, Lesser Knapweed, Marjoram, Meadow Buttercup, Mullen, Ox-eye Daisy, Ragged Robin, Red Campion, Red Clover, Ribwort Plantain, Rough Hawkbit, Salad Burnet, Selfheal, St Johnswort, Wild Angelica, Wild Carrot, Yarrow, Yellow Agrimony, Yellow Rattle. Annuals included: Corn Marigold, Corn Poppy, Corncockle.

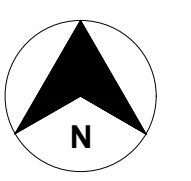
