I gcomhréir le Cuid X1 de na hAchtanna um Pleanáil agus Forbairt, 2000 (arna leasú) agus Cuid 8, Airteagal 81 de na Rialacháin um Pleanáil agus Forbairt, 2001 go dtí 2024, tugann Comhairle Cathrach na Gaillimhe fógra leis seo go bhfuil sé ar intinn aici an fhorbairt seo a leanas a dhéanamh ag Bóthar na Ceapaí, Cnoc na Cathrach, Gaillimh.

Is é a bheidh i gceist leis an bhforbairt Forbairt Tithíochta Sóisialta agus Inacmhainne Beartaithe ar 2 láithreán nasctha ar Bhóthar na Ceapaí, Cathair na Gaillimhe, atá comhdhéanta de:

- 38 n-aonad cónaithe nua a thógáil atá comhdhéanta de:
- 12 theach sraithe (6 theach 2 sheomra leapa agus 6 theach 3 sheomra leapa)
- 1 teach cathrach 2 sheomra leapa
- 5 aonad 2 stór 2 sheomra leapa
- 4 árasán 2 sheomra leapa 4 dhuine lena ndoras féin
- 11 n-árasán 2 sheomra leapa 3 dhuine lena ndoras féin
- 5 árasán 1 sheomra leapa lena ndoras féin
- Pointí rochtana feithicle agus coisithe chuig na Tograí trí bhóthar rochtana an Choimín Mhóir/ Gharraí Dhónaill a thógáil
- Bearta deartha fuinnimh in-athnuaite do gach aonad agus
- Oibreacha forbartha tacaíochta, lena n-áirítear:
- Bóithre Rochtana
- Spásanna Páirceála Grúpáilte
- Tírdhreachú agus cóireálacha teorann
- Athruithe ar leibhéal na talún chun freastal ar an bhforbairt

Rinneadh Scagadh le haghaidh Measúnacht Chuí (MC) ar an togra faoin Treoir maidir le Gnáthóga (92/43/CEE) agus Rialacháin na gComhphobal Eorpach (Éin agus Gnáthóga Nádurtha), 2011, (arna leasú), agus Scagadh le haghaidh Measúnacht Tionchair Timpeallachta (MTT) faoi Threoir MTT 2011/92/AE arna leasú le Treoir 2014/52/AE (agus na forálacha ábhartha faoin Acht um Pleanáil agus Forbairt, 2000, arna leasú, agus na Rialacháin um Pleanáil agus Forbairt, 2001, arna leasú). Tháinig an t-údarás ar an gconclúid nach dócha go mbeidh tionchair shuntasacha ar an gcomhshaoil ag eascairt as an bhforbairt bheartaithe agus cinneadh nach bhfuil gá le Measúnacht Chuí ná le Measúnacht Tionchair Timpeallachta. In accordance with Part X1 of the Planning and Development Acts 2000 (as amended) and Part 8, Article 81 of the Planning and Development Regulations 2001 to 2024, Galway City Council gives notice that it intends to carry out the following development at Cappagh Road, Knocknacarra, Galway.

The Development will consist of a Proposed Social and Affordable housing development on 2 connected sites at Cappagh Road, Galway City, consisting of:

- The construction of 38 no. new residential units comprising of:
- 12 no. Terraced houses (6no. 2 bedroom houses & 6 no. 3 bedroom houses)
- 1 no. 2 bedroom townhouse
- 5 no. 2 bedroom 2 storey duplex units
- 4 no. 2 bedroom 4 person own door Apartments
- 11 no. 2 bedroom 3 person own door Apartments
- 5 no. 1 bedroom own door apartments
- The construction of vehicular and pedestrian access points to the Proposals via the An Cimín Mór/ Garrai Dhónaill access road,
- Renewable energy design measures for each unit and
- Supporting development works including:
- Access Roads
- Grouped Parking spaces
- Landscaping and boundary treatments
- Ground level alterations to accommodate the development
- Bicycle storage and bin storage
- Surface water management including SUDS measures
- Temporary construction signage
- Estate signage and
- All associated site works.

The proposal has undergone Appropriate Assessment (AA) Screening under the Habitats Directive (92/43/EEC) and the European Communities (Bird and Natural Habitats) Regulations 2011 (as amended), and Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) Screening under the EIA Directive 2011/92/EU, as amended by Directive 2014/52/EU, (and the relevant provisions of the Planning and Development Act 2000, as amended, and the Planning and Development Regulations 2001, as amended). The authority has concluded that there is no likelihood of significant effects on the environment arising from the proposed development and a determination has been made that an AA and EIA are not required. In accordance with Article 120 of the Planning and Development Regulations 2001 (as amended), any person may, at any time before the expiration of 4 weeks beginning on the date of this notice, apply to An Bord Pleanála for a screening determination as to whether the proposed development would be likely to have significant effects on the environment.

Plans and Particulars of the proposed development may be inspected or purchased at a fee not exceeding the reasonable cost of making a copy for a period of **4 weeks from 12/03/2026** during public opening hours at the offices of **Planning Office, Galway City Council, City Hall, College Road, Galway City, Monday - Friday 9.00am to 4.00pm**.
