	<b>High Quality Concrete Paving - type 1</b> Concrete block paving with exposed aggregate finish, in line with Galway Public Realm Strategy (General Upgrade Area) and Cross City Bus Link. Product and laying details to be agreed with CCBL team to create seamless finish to public realm.
	<b>High Quality Concrete Paving - type 2</b> Concrete flag paving with exposed aggregate finish, in line with Galway Public Realm Strategy (General Upgrade Area) and Cross City Bus Link. Product and laying details to be agreed with CCBL team to create seamless finish to public realm.
	<b>Natural Stone Paving - type 1</b> Irish granite setts in three tones random laid to raised crossing, in line with Galway Public Realm Strategy.
	<b>Natural Stone Paving - type 2</b> Irish limestone flags to pedestrian areas, in line with Galway Public Realm Strategy. Specification to match existing adjacent paving to Waterlode.
	<b>Resin Bound Gravel - type 1</b> Permeable resin bound gravel suitable for occasional trafficking and installation within tree Root Protection Areas, installed on suitable sub-base. Colour: Mix of golden and neutral aggregates.
	<b>Resin Bound Gravel - type 2</b> Permeable resin bound gravel suitable for occasional trafficking and installation within tree Root Protection Areas, installed on suitable sub-base. Colour: Mix of grey and neutral aggregates.
	<b>Tactile Paving - Courtesy Crossings</b> Natural stone flag paving, 400 x 400mm dark grey granite blazer paving for uncontrolled courtesy crossings, in line with Galway Public Realm Strategy.
	<b>Tactile Paving - Hazard Warning</b> Natural stone flag paving, 400 x 400mm dark grey granite blazer warning paving to identify start and end of shared surface area, in line with Galway Public Realm Strategy.
	<b>Boardwalk to Rain Garden</b> Timber boardwalk to create raised walkway through Rain Garden
<b>Kerbs and Edges</b>	
	<b>Existing Kerb - Retained</b> 150mm wide height varies.
	<b>Natural Stone Kerb - Upstand</b> 150mm wide, light grey granite kerb, hammered finish, in line with Galway Public Realm Strategy.
	<b>Natural Stone Kerb - Transition</b> 150mm wide, light grey granite kerb, hammered finish, in line with Galway Public Realm Strategy.
	<b>Natural Stone Kerb - Flush</b> 150mm wide, light grey granite kerb, hammered finish, in line with Galway Public Realm Strategy.
	<b>Natural Stone Edging - Flush</b> 150mm wide, light grey granite edging, hammered finish, in line with Galway Public Realm Strategy.
	<b>Steel Edging - Flush</b> Flexible steel edging to resin bound surfacing.
<b>Line Marking</b>	
	<b>Line marking to roads</b> White line markings - refer to Civil Engineers Proposals
	<b>Yellow line marking to accessible parking spaces</b> Yellow line markings - refer to Civil Engineers Proposals
<b>Furniture</b>	
	<b>Free-standing Feature Seating</b> Refer to Hard Landscape Plans for details
	<b>Curved Seating</b> Refer to Hard Landscape Plans for details
	<b>Litter Bins</b> Rectangular steel litter bin. Powder coated micaceous iron oxide grey/RAL7024, in line with Galway Public Realm Strategy.
	<b>Bollards</b> Powder coated steel bollard, powder coated micaceous iron oxide grey/RAL7024 with brushed 316 grade stainless steel polished cap top and reflective strip, in line with Galway Public Realm Strategy.
	<b>Drop Bollards</b> Powder coated steel bollard, powder coated micaceous iron oxide grey/RAL7024 with brushed 316 grade stainless steel polished cap top and reflective strip, in line with Galway Public Realm Strategy. Supplied with removable finish.
	<b>Cycle Hire Bins</b> Relocation of existing TIF bike hire stands (106x).
<b>Special Features</b>	
	<b>ICA Memorial</b> Relocation of existing stone ICA Memorial, currently located within the Park. Approximate dimensions 400mm x 400mm. Location TBC.
	<b>Galway Orb</b> Installation of existing centron sculpture used during the Galway City of Culture ceremony, 2000mmØ perforated spiral set on 800mmØ, 500mm high C845 column, welded to 2000mm square steel frame.
<b>Lighting</b>	
	<b>Existing Street Lighting</b> To be retained
	<b>Path Lighting</b> 1m high lighting bollards, warm light LED source (2200K), dark sky approved. Indicative spacing only - refer to Don O'Malley lighting plan for details.
	<b>Galway Orb</b> Lighting to be incorporated to internal base of Orb to illuminate the site-specific images and text. Refer to Don O'Malley lighting plan for details.
