I am requesting that an Bord Pleanála reject the current proposal for the redevelopment of Woodquay Park. REF ABP-320938-24.

My objection relates to the removal of trees and rails along with the removal of the gates. This will make it unsafe for my child to play here safely. I do not understand the current concept of a hill and paths for kids to play on as depicted in the plans. Children need open space and possible a swing and slide.

We live next to the park and currently use it regularly. We have no garden so this park and the plots are the closest green area for my child to play.

The park simple needs better up keep. The paths are currently slippy and the grass is not kept cut. Instead of spending a massive amount of money on this redesign perhaps simple keeping the rails and gates , removing some of the hedges and adding some planters and redeveloping the footpath would be a much simpler solution.

If a complete redesign is absolutely necessary it should be done with locals in mind. Possible include a secure place to keeps bicycles or a small recycling section. A planting box for each of the house would also be a nice idea. One that was active many years ago.
